Objective

The objective of Battlefield Shooting Range is to encourage the organized sportsmanship of shooting among the citizens of the United States residing in our community. Our main goal is to further member's knowledge on proper care, handling, and marksmanship. It shall further be the objective of Battlefield Shooting Range to enhance the integrity, sportsmanship, self-discipline, teamwork, and good citizenship which are all characteristics of a true American.

Membership Requirements:

- 1. Must be a citizen of the United States of America natural or legalized. The only exception to this rule are foreign nationals legally here training with the U.S. Military or visiting an American Citizen family member.
- 2. Must be a Citizen of good character and not be a member of any organization that harbors the intention of causing harm to American Citizens or the Government of the United States.
- 3. Must not be a convicted felon as defined by the State of Mississippi.
- 4. Must render monthly dues and fees in the specified time.
- 5. Be at least 18 years of age for long guns and 21 for pistols.
- 6. Submit your application with your annual dues to Battlefield Shooting Range.
- 7. Must be knowledgeable in weapons handling safety and have had a range safety briefing offered by staff Instructors.
- 8. Respect all range safety rules at all times.
- 9. Must not have been found by a court, board, commission, or other lawful authority to be a danger to themselves or others, or to lack "the mental capacity to contract or manage [their] own affairs," as a result of their mental condition or illness.

Battlefield Shooting Range

Firing Range Rules:

- 1. Sign in at the target shed BEFORE entering the range areas and raise the Red Flag when the range is hot, and lower the Red Flag if you are the last to leave.
- 2. All guns to be used on range must be unloaded prior to entering office and classroom area.
- 3. No intoxicating substances on the premises, including parking areas. Use of the premises is prohibited to anyone who has consumed such substances.
- 4. Upon entering the range area, all commands of Range Officer or posted rules shall be followed.
- 5. Approved eye and ear protection must be worn at all times while on the range.
- 6. You must be 21 years old to shoot a handgun & 18 years old to shoot a long gun unless accompanied by a parent or legal guardian.
- 7. NO food of any kind is permitted on the range. Picnic area only.
- 8. All guns used on the range must be in safe operating condition and used only with the proper ammunition including hand-loaded ammunition.
- 9. Always keep the gun pointed in a safe direction.
- 10. Always keep your finger off the trigger until ready to shoot.
- 11. Know your target and what is beyond it.
- 12. All ranges to the left of the range flag (from the road) are handgun/shotgun only. DO NOT shoot steel targets on the handgun ranges with high velocity rifle grade ammo.
- 13. Steel Targets on the Handgun Range are to be shot from **21** feet or more away.
- 14. There are to be NO hand-to-hand transfers of firearms. If you want to pass a firearm to another shooter, place the weapon on the firing line bench and step back. The other shooter may step forward and pick up the weapon.
- 15. Loading or unloading of any firearm or magazines will be done on the firing line bench.
- 16. There is to be NO firing a firearm from the hip. This includes pistol grip shotguns.
- 17. Be considerate of other shooters by practicing good sportsmanship, being respectful, and using good common sense.
- 18. All club members must display their membership badge while on the property in an easily identifiable location.
- 19. IF you bring your own targets, i.e., plastic bottles or jugs, clean up your trash before you leave. No glass bottles or porcelain plates for targets will be used at any time.
- 20. Members may not under any circumstance loan or grant access codes to the gates without permission of Battlefield Shooting Range Management!
- 21. Persons under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a parent or responsible adult.
- 22. Clean your area before leaving the range.
- 23. No rifles allowed in handgun ranges.
- 24. Battlefield Shooting Range reserves the right to reject or refuse anyone access to all facilities.
- 25. Range hours are 8 a.m. until dusk, Mon-Sat and 1 p.m. until dusk on Sundays.

Battlefield Shooting Range Dress Code:

- 1. No Flip-Flops, Sandals, or Open Footwear of any kind allowed.
- 2. No Tank Tops of Low-Cut Tops allowed
- 3. Extremes in apparel or jewelry, which are distractive, disruptive, disrespectful or unsafe will not be permitted.
- 4. Clothing or jewelry displaying: drugs, obscenities, lewd or illegal behavior, sexual overtones, etc. or any reference that is disruptive to others.
- 5. Undergarments worn as outer garments are not permitted, including muscle shirts.
- 6. Torn or ragged clothing will not be permitted.
